




WE ARE INVOLVED:



WHILE HERE...

- Have you been **forced to have sexual relations**?
- Have you been **abused** or beaten?
- Has anyone forced or attempted to **marry you** against your will?
- Has anyone **harassed** you to fall in love or have intimate relationships with someone?
- Have you been injured on your **genitals**?
- Have you been **forced to work as a prostitute**?
- Has **your documentation been taken from you**?
- Were you **promised a job** and have had to **work without having breaks and/or not been paid**?
- Are you trans and have you been persecuted for that?

If the answer to any of these questions is yes, you could ask the Spanish authorities to protect you.



WE WILL:

- tell you how to get protection and help you in the process



- offer counselling and social support



- tell you what other services are available



WE ARE WITH YOU!

Everyone has the right to seek **protection** outside their country of origin and to be protected if they are **fleeing persecution** on the grounds of ethnicity, religion, nationality, political opinions, **gender, sexual orientation, gender identity** or fleeing from an **armed conflict**.

Women are sometimes **persecuted just because we are women** and we may be forced to flee our country. We may also be more vulnerable during the journey and when we arrive in the host country where our fundamental rights are severely violated.
